Re:	Integrated earnings reporting process improvement

To streamline the integrated earnings submission process for employers and to increase 3sHealth's internal efficiency, 3sHealth has introduced an improved method for submitting all integrated earnings.

The change eliminates employers having to complete the <u>"Disability Income Plan – Integrated Earnings</u> <u>Report" form</u> for each individual plan member. In the new method, employers will provide integrated earnings for all employees in one spreadsheet. For ease-of-access, 3sHealth will post the spreadsheet on the DDS in each employer's "EBP Correspondence" folder every Tuesday morning. 3sHealth will provide a list of plan members that require earnings to be submitted in columns A to M.

3sHealth's Claims Payment Officers will continue to follow their process of requesting earnings from employers for plan members not included on the report. Employers can also add records of employees on integrated earnings to the report if needed.
